GENERAL INFORMATION

This will be the 24th year that members of UCC churches in Minnesota and their friends have joined hands to build houses for Habitat for Humanity and the 22nd year in Coahoma County Mississippi.

Habitat for Humanity is a project where volunteer workers work in partnership with new homeowners to build homes. The new homeowners are a low income family and they must contribute from 250 to 500 hours of work towards their home or another Habitat home.

The family then buys the house for the cost of materials and land on a zero interest loan from Habitat for Humanity. As they may their loan payments, the money is used to build more houses for other low income families.

Many of the campers to the work camp combine a winter vacation with their time of work at the Habitat Project.

No specific skills are needed to work on the Habitat project and age is no restriction. We have had workers who are in their eighties participate in past work camps.

Every effort will be made to arrange riders with drivers for those who wish transportation to attend a work camp.
