

## Where to report COVID-19 Executive Order Violations:

- For enforcement of required face coverings, social distancing, capacity limits per Exec Orders: Refer callers to the SAH (“StayAtHome”) Violations Helpline at 651-793-3746 or email [sahviolations@state.mn.us](mailto:sahviolations@state.mn.us)
