## JOB SUMMARY

Build relationships among youth and families of the church. Collaborate with the Minister of Congregational Life to program and provide a meaningful, relevant, deepening, and fun Youth Group Ministry and create a sense of community for our youth. This will include Youth Group gatherings for middle school and senior high youth, mission/service learning trips and retreats. Also includes the possibility of being involved in Confirmation. YCB will be expected to be present during formal youth program times (most typically on Sunday afternoons or early evenings) and for Sunday worship when pre-arranged and when aligned with youth programming. Role is 15 hours per month, 12 months per year.
